

Spring Lake Park

Park Rules & Regulations



PARK HOURS: 96.01(A)

City Parks are open to the public between the hours of 5:00AM and 10:00pm

PETS: ORDINANCE 92.01(A1)

No person shall allow an animal to run at large within the City. (A3) Animals may be allowed off their premises as long as they are on a leash. (E) No person shall allow an animal under his or her control to defecate in City parks or public land without picking it up and disposing of it in a sanitary manner.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN CITY PARKS:

Use of motorized vehicles are restricted to roadways and parking lots. 96.01 (B) No overnight parking of a vehicle between the hours of 10:00PM and 5:00AM is allowed.

TOBACCO USE:

All City parks are tobacco free. Tobacco Free Policy.

ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION: 11.08.010(E)

No person shall consume or possess intoxicating liquor of 3.2% malt liquor in any City Park, unless specifically approved by City Council or as permitted during a special event. This prohibition shall include parking areas connected with the parks.

FEEDING WILDLIFE:

Due to health concerns feeding the wildlife is discouraged. Keep wildlife wild.

SKATE PARK:

The skate park rules must be adhered to for the safety of all participants.

WATER CRAFT: 96.22(B)

The use of motorboats within the City is prohibited.

SNOWMOBILES: 70.46(A)

Snowmobiles may not be operated upon or within any City park of the City.

CHARCOAL GRILLS:

No charcoal fires except in designated parks which currently is **ONLY Lakeside Lions Park.**
